



# Ruddington Crime Survey

## ***RESULTS***




**We sent a crime survey to all  
residents in Ruddington asking  
them the following questions.**

**We had 121 responses.**

# **Q1. On a scale from 0-10, how safe do you feel in your neighbourhood?**

Generally, people seem to feel fairly safe in Ruddington with 83% of respondents giving a safety score of 5 or over.



## **Q2. How satisfied are you with the police presence in Ruddington?**


Despite feeling fairly safe, people in Ruddington are not happy with the lack of a police presence.

65% of respondents said they are either somewhat or very dissatisfied with the police presence. Only 8% of respondents said they are either somewhat or very satisfied and 27% said they are neither satisfied or dissatisfied.




# **Q3. What are your biggest crime concerns in Ruddington?**

The top 3 crime issues in Ruddington (totalling over 92% of responses) are Burglary and Robbery, Road Offences/Speeding, and Anti-Social Behaviour.



\*Illegal Parking, Littering, Car parts theft, E-Scooters, Knife Crime, Domestic Abuse.

## **Q4. Have you witnessed or been the victim of theft or burglary?**



26% of respondents said they have witnessed  
or been the victim of a theft or burglary.


# Q4a. Reoccurring Reports:

Of those who had reported being a victim of theft or burglary, car theft was reported back the most times, with shed break-ins closely following.

## **Q5. If you have reported a crime, how satisfied were you with the police response?**



39% of people who have reported a crime to the police said they were very satisfied or somewhat satisfied with the police response.

32% said they were very dissatisfied or somewhat dissatisfied with 29% reporting they were neither satisfied or dissatisfied.
